- 1. Goebel Hummel Marks can be blue, or black underglaze, or overglaze. And in some instances can be a combination of incised and backstamped marks.
- 2. Goebel and experienced collectors acknowledge there may be occasional undocumented Goebel Hummel marks that are authentic.
- 3. Beginning and ending dates could include last 6 months of previous year and/or first 6 months of following year.
